# FROM THE DIRECTOR

Before the show begins, let me just say: it's okay to laugh!

When I first read this play, I couldn't stop myself from laughing—not just from the sheer brilliance of Larissa FastHorse's satirical writing but from the realization that I, too, have sometimes been guilty of what these characters are doing and saying. It's easy to use the buzz words and the popular language surrounding equity and racial justice, but this play made me ask myself: **are my words louder than my actions?** 

This play represents the kind of material we love to do at The 5 & Dime. It's a challenging task to find a comedy that sparks conversation and encourages such introspection; when this play was suggested to us by one of our Artistic Team members, we felt that now was the perfect time to tackle this play. FastHorse skillfully examines words vs. actions and how inaction truly inspires inaction. She also shines a light on how the story of the first Thanksgiving is taught in this country. You'll see interludes between the scenes that are (unfortunately) based on real lesson plans that FastHorse discovered during her research for this play. Through it all, I hope you'll find this piece as the definition of a "ha, ha, hmm" piece (laughter, laughter, thought.)

I am so grateful to this extraordinary team who have poured their insight, passion, and playfulness into this process. Time and time again, they've been unendingly willing to take on the task or the challenge immediately in front of them with such grace and humility. They are a director's dream. A special shoutout to my assistant director Zach Rivera, who is the finest collaborator. Thank you, Zach, for everything.
